Romans 6:8-14

- ⁸ Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him.
- ⁹ For we know that since Christ was raised from the dead, he cannot die again; death no longer has mastery over him.
- ¹⁰ The death he died, he died to sin once for all; but the life he lives, he lives to God.
- ¹¹ In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus.
- ¹² Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its evil desires.
- ¹³ Do not offer any part of yourself to sin as an instrument of wickedness, but rather offer yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life; and offer every part of yourself to him as an instrument of righteousness.
- ¹⁴ For sin shall no longer be your master, because you are not under the law, but under grace.

1. God created us in His image.

2. Our common problem: SIN

Sin: An entity, a presence, a strange power that drives us not to be the very person God intends us to become; an entity that entices us so that we may not experience all the good things that God has in store for us.

- **3. Jesus took care of our sin problem by taking our place:** He died to sin on the cross and rose to new life from the dead.
- 4. How to experience new life in Christ (3 important steps of spiritual truths)

(1) Knowing

Romans 6:3, 6, 9

- ³ Or don't you **know** that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death?
- ⁶ For we **know** that our old self was crucified with him so that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin--
- ⁹ For we **know** that since Christ was raised from the dead, he cannot die again; death no longer has mastery over him.

(2) Counting

Romans 6:11

¹¹ In the same way, **count** yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus.

Colossians 3:1-4

- ¹ Since, then, <u>you have been raised with Christ</u>, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God.
- ² <u>Set your minds on things above</u>, not on earthly things.
- ³ For <u>you died</u>, and <u>your life is NOW hidden with Christ</u> in God.
- ⁴ When Christ, who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.
- ¹⁰ ...the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator.

Romans 12:2

² Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but <u>be</u> transformed by the renewing of your mind.

(3) Offering ourselves to God

Romans 6:13

¹³ Do not offer the parts of your body to sin, as instruments of wickedness, but rather <u>offer yourselves to God</u>, as those who have been brought from death to life; and offer the parts of your body to him <u>as instruments of righteousness</u>.
