5 ways to cultivate friendship with God

- 1. Obedience
- 2. Belief in justification by faith alone
- 3. Dynamic two-way communication
- 4. Seeking His face
- 5. Meditating on Jesus' death as an act of friendship

(Today's speaker is the beloved late Dr. Timothy Keller who was the senior pastor of Redeemer Presbyterian Church in New York.)

Theme: Friendship with God (It's possible, why, and how)

- The Lord's Prayer teaches us what we should pray.
- Prayers in the book of Psalms teach us how to pray.

KEY VERSE: PSALM 25:14

¹⁴ The *<u>friendship</u> of the LORD is for those who fear him, and he makes known to them his covenant. (ESV)

(*friendship: "TİO" - 'sod': The secret counsel (familiar converse, intimacy)

Common aspect of today's spirituality

"I am spiritual but not religious." What does this mean?

♦ I want to be inspired and feel connected. But I don't want discipline. I want to live my life the way I want to live.

THE BIBLE TEACHES THAT FRIENDSHIP WITH GOD IS POSSIBLE.

1. IT IS POSSIBLE.

¹¹ Thus the LORD used to speak to Moses face to face, as a man speaks to his friend. When Moses turned again into the camp, his assistant Joshua the son of Nun, a young man, would not depart from the tent. **Exodus 33:11**

²³ and the Scripture was fulfilled that says, "Abraham believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness"—and he was called a friend of God. **James 2:23**

2. THE REASON WHY IT IS POSSIBLE: Friendship as an 'You too?' experience

- (1) Doctrine of God Trinity (Tri-personal in the Godhead)
- (2) The whole history of redemption one gigantic cosmic act of friendship

We can say to God, "You too?"

3. THE WAY HOW IT IS POSSIBLE: Friendship gives us the framework of prayer - 5 ways to cultivate friendship with God

(1) OBEDIENCE

¹⁴ You are my friends if you do what I command you. **John 15:14**

¹⁸ If I had cherished iniquity in my heart, the Lord would not have listened. **Psalm 66:18**

- Holiness more spending time together, more becoming like each other. God already did His part by His incarnation. What about us? How far are we willing to go to be like Him?
- ♦ Let that person be him/herself God accepts us as we are. Do we accept God as He is? He is the Creator, and the Lord of all.
- ♦ What is it that we want with God? We can't expect just a feeling of intimacy from our relationship with God. It must be our transformed life that we want.

(2) BELIEF IN JUSTIFICATION BY FAITH ALONE

² but his delight is in the law of the LORD, and on his law he meditates day and night.

Psalm 1:2

Dr. Martin Lloyd Jones: "God saved me from the sermon on the Mount."

(3) DYNAMIC TWO-WAY COMMUNICATION

Communication is both speaking and hearing. Do we hear God clearly? If it's vague, then it must not have been from God since in a friendship, we want to communicate as clearly, truthfully, and honestly as possible. Just like we speak to God what we have in our heart clearly, God speaks to us what He has in His heart clearly. There comes the importance of the written Word of God. It is clear!

(4) SEEKING HIS FACE: PERSONAL AND REAL EXPERIENCE OF GOD

(5) MEDITATING ON JESUS' DEATH AS AN ACT OF FRIENDSHIP

Candor and **Constancy:** Jesus opened Himself completely for us, His hands were even nailed on the cross to come to us with complete transparency, and He stayed there for us until He died. We see God's friendship with us on the cross.
