### NOT MY WILL, BUT YOURS BE DONE Indicators of New Life (Part 2)

Matthew 26:36-44 (See also Luke 22:39-46; Mark 14:32-40)

<sup>36</sup> Then Jesus went with his disciples to a place called Gethsemane, and he said to them, "Sit here while I go over there and pray."

<sup>37</sup> He took Peter and the two sons of Zebedee along with him, and he began to be sorrowful and troubled.

<sup>38</sup> Then he said to them, "My soul is overwhelmed with sorrow to the point of death. Stay here and keep watch with me."

<sup>39</sup> Going a little farther, he fell with his face to the ground and prayed, "My Father, if it is possible, may this cup be taken from me. Yet not as I will, but as you will."

<sup>40</sup> Then he returned to his disciples and found them sleeping.

"Could you men not keep watch with me for one hour?" he asked Peter.

<sup>41</sup> "Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing, but the body is weak."

<sup>42</sup> He went away a second time and prayed, "My Father, if it is not possible for this cup to be taken away unless I drink it, may your will be done."

<sup>43</sup> When he came back, he again found them sleeping, because their eyes were heavy.

<sup>44</sup> So he left them and went away once more and prayed the third time, saying the same thing.

Definition of life (from a dictionary)

• The condition that distinguishes animals and plants from inorganic matter, including the capacity for growth,

reproduction, functional activity, and continual change preceding death (Example - The origins of life)

- The existence of an individual human being or animal. (In that accident, we lost 12 lives.)
- The period between the birth and death of a living thing, especially a human being. (His life was short. She had a very long, prosperous life.)
- Vitality, vigor, or **e**nergy. (Young people are full of life!)

### Two kinds of life (John 12:25)

<sup>25</sup> Anyone who loves their <u>life</u> will lose it, while anyone who hates their <u>life</u> in this world will keep it for eternal <u>life</u>.

# Jesus came to give us life (John 10:10)

<sup>10</sup> The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have <u>life</u>, and have it to the full.

# Blessing (Genesis 1:28)

28 God blessed them...

- First of all, only God can bless. So, there is no other blessing except God's blessing.
- Second, blessing is given, not earned.
- Third, blessing is authority. There are power, provision, and protection in authority.

# **Characteristics of blessing**

- Blessing flows through authority (From higher authority to lower authority)
- Blessing flows within boundaries and guidelines set by the higher authority.
- Blessing is taken away when it's exercised outside the boundaries.

God created us in His blessing: Living beings Genesis 2:7
<sup>7</sup> The Lord God <u>formed</u> the man from the dust of the ground and <u>breathed</u> into his nostrils <u>the breath of life</u>, and the man became a <u>living being</u>.

### **God wants us to know the reality of two kinds of life** Genesis 2:16-17

<sup>16</sup> And the Lord God <u>commanded</u> the man, "You are free to <u>eat from any tree in the garden;</u>

<sup>17</sup> but you <u>must not eat from the tree of the knowledge of</u> <u>good and evil</u>, for <u>when you eat of it you will surely die</u>."

# The enemy's goal: To take our blessing away from us by deceiving us with what is seemingly desirable Genesis 3:7 <sup>7</sup> Then <u>the eyes of both of them were opened</u>, and <u>they</u> <u>realized they were naked</u>; so they sewed fig leaves together and made coverings for themselves.

#### Genesis 3:5

5 For God knows that when you eat from of the tree, **your eyes will be opened**, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil.

# The reality of sin is attractive Genesis 3:6

<sup>6</sup> When the woman saw that the fruit of the tree was good for food and pleasing to the eye, and also desirable for gaining wisdom...

# Sin: To become our own god against the truth God by establishing our own judgement call Genesis 3:22

<sup>22</sup> And the Lord God said, "The man has now become like one of us, knowing good and evil... Indicators of old life: Making our own judgment call by ignoring God-given authority Genesis 3:11

<sup>11</sup> "Who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten from the tree that I commanded you not to eat from?"

\*Adam (his own wisdom and insight) told himself that they were naked. (We are naked. Therefore, we are ashamed.)

### Judges 21:25

<sup>25</sup> In those days Israel had no king; everyone did as he saw fit.

# **Indicators of new life: Not my will but Yours be done.** Matthew 26:39, 42, 44

<sup>39</sup> <u>Going a little farther</u>, he fell with his face to the ground and prayed, "My Father, if it is possible, may this cup be taken from me. Yet not as I will, but as you will."

<sup>42</sup> He went away a second time and prayed, "My Father, if it is not possible for this cup to be taken away unless I drink it, may your will be done."

<sup>44</sup> So he left them and went away once more and prayed <u>the</u> <u>third time, saying the same thing.</u>

#### Application

- 1. Do I understand the blessing of God?
- 2. Am I living in the authority of God?
  - God's Word is my final authority: Am I exercising my God-given authority within the boundary?
  - Am I receiving God's blessing by obeying Godestablished higher authorities in my life? (Family authority, spiritual authority, general authorities for the order in society)
- 3. Is there any of my own judgement call in my life?
