Truth #1

"My spiritual growth is God's plan, God's design, and God's will for me."

WHAT IS SPIRITUAL MATURITY?

Ephesians 4:13

¹³ (The body of Christ may be built up) until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and <u>become mature</u>, <u>attaining to the whole</u> measure of the fullness of Christ.

Spiritual maturity: Being like Christ

Romans 8:29

²⁹ For those God foreknew (Christians) he also predestined to be conformed to the likeness of his Son (Jesus Christ)...

Genesis 1:26

²⁶ ...God said, "Let us make man in our image, in our likeness"...

2 Corinthians 3:18

¹⁸ And <u>we</u>, who with unveiled faces all reflect the Lord's glory, <u>are being</u> <u>transformed into his likeness with ever-increasing glory</u>, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit.

WHAT IS OUR SPIRITUAL TRANSFORMATION?

Spiritual transformation is to be more like Jesus Christ, and <u>to be more like</u>

Jesus Christ means to become a person who thinks like Jesus, who feels like

Jesus, and who acts like Jesus.

To be more like Jesus Christ, today's text teaches us to take two steps:

- 1. Get rid of bad attitudes (v1)
- 2. Crave pure spiritual milk (the Word of God) to grow up in our salvation (v2)

THREE BASIC UNDERSTANDINGS THAT WE CHRISTIANS NEED TO PROPERLY HAVE ABOUT OUR SPIRITUAL GROWTH

1. Understanding for our spiritual growth number One:

IT IS A PROCESS.

1 Peter 1:3-5

- ³ Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In his great mercy <u>he</u> <u>has given us new birth</u> into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,
- ⁴ and into an inheritance that can never perish, spoil or fade—kept in heaven for you,
- ⁵ who through faith are shielded by God's power until the coming of the salvation that is ready to be revealed in the last time.

2 Peter 3:18

¹⁸ Continue to grow in the grace and knowledge of our savior Jesus Christ.

Truth #2

The purpose of my life on earth right now is to prepare for my life in eternity.

2. Understanding for our spiritual growth number two:

IT TAKES DISCIPLINE.

- 1 Peter 1:6-7
- ⁶ In this you greatly rejoice, <u>though now for a little while you may have had to</u> suffer grief in all kinds of trials.
- ⁷ These have come so that your faith—of greater worth than gold, which perishes even though refined by fire—may be proved genuine and may result in praise, glory and honor when Jesus Christ is revealed.
- 1 Timothy 4:7
- ⁷ ...Train yourself to be godly.
- 3. Understanding for our spiritual growth number three:

IT'S NOT AUTOMATIC.

1 Peter 1:13-15

¹³ ... Prepare your minds for action (make a commitment); be self-controlled; set your hope fully on the grace to be given you when Jesus Christ is revealed.

¹⁴ As obedient children, do not conform to the evil desires you had when you lived in ignorance.

¹⁵ But just as he who called you is holy, so **be holy in all you do**;

Hebrews 5:12-13

¹² In fact, though by this time <u>you ought to be teachers</u>, you need someone to teach you the elementary truths of God's word all over again. You need milk, not solid food!

¹³ Anyone who lives on milk, <u>being still an infant</u>, is not acquainted with the teaching about righteousness.
